Jubilee Hall 2024 Lottery - help the Jubilee Hall!

A single ticket for the whole year costs £10 and entitles you to take part in 12 draws (drawn quarterly), each with first prize of £30, second prize of £15 and third prize of £5. At Christmas there is a special Bonus Draw - First Prize £60, Second Prize £40, Third Prize £25.

Tickets can be purchased direct from Winsham Shop from Thursday, 1 February 2024 (closing date Sunday, 31 March 2024). The first quarterly draw will be held at the Jubilee Café on Thursday, 18 April 2024. Winners will be notified, and the results will also be published on the Parish Website and on the Jubilee Hall notice board.
