

Minutes of meeting held at The Jubilee Hall, 10 January 2023 (postponed from 6 December 2022)

i) Bryan Goodman, Treasurer, produced the completed Jubilee Hall Lottery Return for 2022 which was duly signed by Sarah Gleadell, Promoter, and ratified by two committee members, Karen Whitworth and Steve Weller.

ii) John Sullivan noted that the number of tickets sold is falling, mainly due to regular purchasers moving away or dying, and that we need to make a real effort to encourage newcomers. Accordingly, after some discussion, it was decided that two different letters would be distributed as hard copies, the first one to existing purchasers would be personalised by hand, the second one to be delivered to all other households in the village, also to the hamlets of Bridge and Ammerham. John Sullivan will draft both letters and email them to committee members tomorrow for approval.

Parish Council rent Steve Weller raised the subject of a possible increase in the rent paid to Jubilee Hall for its use by the Parish Council. Bryan Goodman will liaise with him about this and will report back to the committee

Short Mat Bowls Bryan Goodman is proposing that the Jubilee Hall starts a Short Mat Bowls Club. He has acquired the necessary equipment and a taster weekend will take place on 14/15 January. Two experienced players from an existing Club have agreed to attend in order to help demonstrate the equipment. Steve Weller has a set of woods which he kindly offered to loan to the Club on a long term basis. The proposed annual membership fee is £20, plus £3 for each session attended. The plan is to hold two sessions a week, one during the day and one in the evening. Those attending for the weekend taster will be canvassed for their opinion on times and preferred day of the week. Helpers will be needed at the weekend and it is hoped that some committee members will become regular players and help with organisation.
