Critically acclaimed poignant drama, with universal themes of family and belonging. 2018 Cannes film festival Palme d'Or winner.

### **7th November: Wajib** (2017, Palestine)

Comedy-drama revealing the layers of the relationship between father and son.

### **5th December: Blackkklansman** (2018, US)

An African-American police officer goes undercover to infiltrate the Ku Klux Klan in order to thwart an attempt to take over the city.

### **2nd January: Faces Places** (2017, France)

A female Director and a French photographer travel around French villages observing local people and traditions.

### **6th February : Jules et Jim** (1962, France)

A classic tale of a love triangle which takes place over 20 years, before and after WWI.

### **5th March : The Salesman** (2017, Iran)

A couple's relationship unravels as they prepare for their roles in a local theatre production. Nominated for Golden Globe Award for Best Foreign Language Film.

### **2nd April : Lady MacBeth** (2016, UK)

A gothic tale of a young bride trapped in a marriage of convenience who embarks on a passionate affair.
