9th October **Their Finest** (12A) 117 mins

A young girl (Gemma Arterton) is hired by the Ministry of Information in World War II to write scripts for propaganda films aimed at boosting morale. As she follows up a likely story, the film offers a mixture of comedy, drama and romance -- with a standout performance by Bill Nighy as an actor who will not accept that his days as a leading man are over. Directed by Lone Scherfig (An Education).

13th November **The Sense of an Ending** (15) 108 mins

Tony (Jim Broadbent), a curmudgeonly divorced man, is forced to confront his past when he receives a mysterious legacy from the mother of his university girlfriend, Veronica. With Charlotte Rampling, Harriet Walter and Emily Mortimer. Based on the novel by Julian Barnes.

18th December **The Red Turtle** (PG) 80 mins

A man is shipwrecked on a deserted island and encounters a red turtle, which changes his life. This film includes a nail-biting drama, a touch of romance and a profound engagement with the cycle of life, all rendered in an exquisite line-drawing style that's elemental in its simplicity. Nominated for Best Animated Feature Film of the Year. Ostensibly a children's film, this also has much to offer to adults.

All films will be shown in Hawkchurch Village Hall.

The October and November films will be shown at 7.30pm. Doors open 7pm. Tickets £6.

The December film will be a matinee, with doors opening at 1:20pm and main film starting at 1:50pm. Adults £6, children £3.
